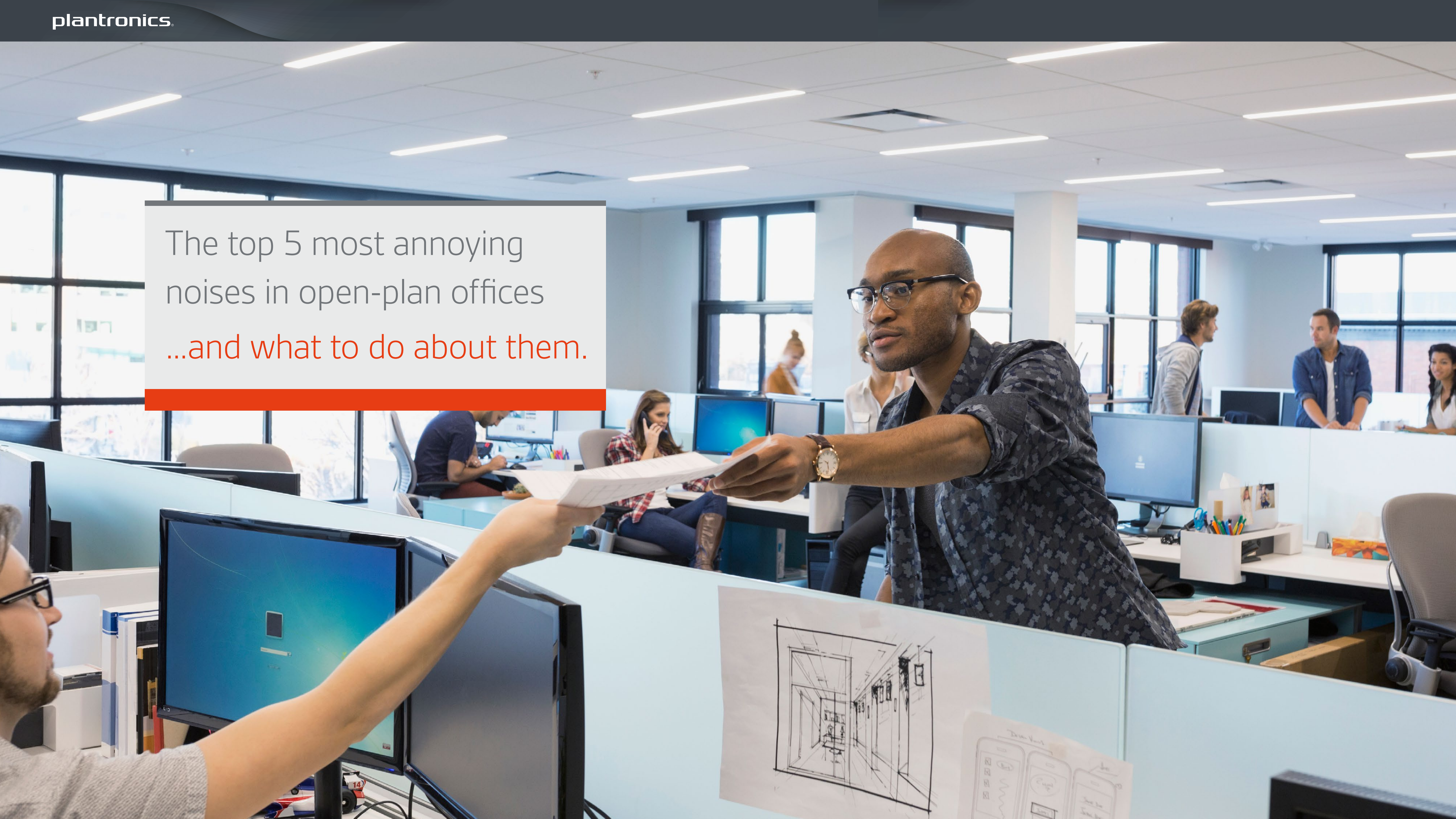
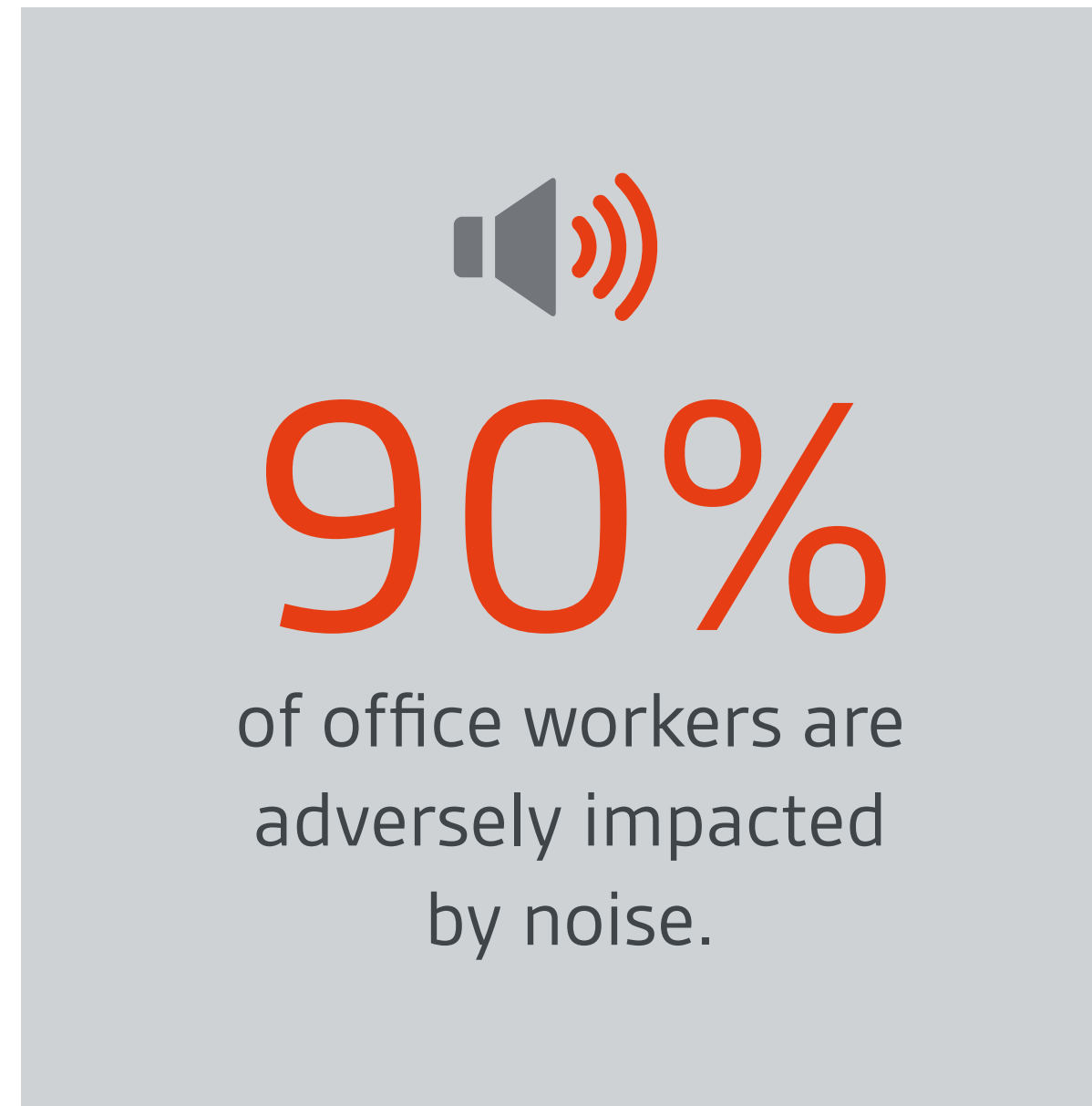


The top 5 most annoying noises in open-plan offices

## **Solution:**

Stereo headset with active noise canceling (ANC) technology

### **Solution:**

Wireless headsets to allow movement away from your office desk



3. The background noise created by electronic office equipment

**Solution:**

Use masking sounds, such as pink noise or ANC technology



## 4. Bad office acoustics

### **Solution:**

Install noise-absorbing ceiling tiles





## 5. Proximity to communal spaces

**Solution:**  
Better acoustic  
workspace planning
